## **Solvents And Thinners**

Acetone has a fast drying time and is an effective heavy duty cleanup solvent.

<u>Boiled Linseed Oil</u> is used for protecting and sealing wood and improving application flow of finishes.

Japan Drier helps speed up drying time between coats.

<u>Lacquer Thinner</u> is used for cleaning sprayers and equipment, and improves flow of lacquer.

<u>Less Flammable\* Paint Thinner for SCAQMD</u> is a premium, highly refined formula that dries with minimal residue, and is an excellent cleaner for paint brushes, tools and equipment immediately after use.

M.E.K. (Methyl Ethyl Ketone) is used for thinning polyester, epoxies, vinyls, and adhesives.

<u>Paint Thinner</u> is used for thinning oil-based paint, stain, and varnishes.
