
## Put a bead in any board





While building a cabinet recently, I decided I wanted a beadedboard look on the doors, but didn't want to hassle with beading a solid-wood panel. (Router bits designed for this task don't work in the middle of a panel.)

So, using a dado set on my tablesaw, I made my own by cutting  $\frac{1}{4}$  " grooves where I wanted the beads. After breaking the

edges of each groove, I glued a  $\frac{1}{4}$  " dowel into each groove. The end result: It looks just like the real McCoy. Try using this technique with a contrasting species of dowel for visual effect.
